

To customers who have a residence card and are applying to open an account

When applying to open a bank account under your own name, you will need the following documents to confirm your period of stay, etc. Please prepare them in advance.
Please use our reservation service when you visit the bank.

<What to prepare>

- ① **Residence Card:** We will confirm your period of stay, etc. If your period of stay will end in less than three months from when you apply to open an account, we will not be able to accept your application, so please ensure that you apply after extending your period of stay.

- ② **Student ID/Employee ID (if you have one):** If your status is “Student” or “Technical Intern Training,” please present your student ID or certificate of enrollment (employee ID), etc., with your residence card so we can confirm the fact you are employed, the status of your work, etc.
- ③ **Your seal or signature (excluding rubber seals such as Shachihata)**

<Other points to note>

- It may take some time for your account to be opened. Furthermore, please be aware that in certain cases, we may refuse to open an account.
- If you exceed your period of stay once your account is open, restrictions may be placed on certain transactions, so please make sure you inform Mizuho Bank when you have extended your period of stay.
- If you are returning to your home country or moving to another country at the end of your period of stay, please carry out the procedures to close your account.
- If you have previously traded or transferred an account, you may not be able to open an account with Mizuho Bank or any other bank in the future.
Please do not trade or transfer an account.
